The term "Maundy" comes from the Latin word *mandatum*, which means "commandment." It refers to Jesus' command to his disciples at the Last Supper to love one another, as he loved them (John 13:34-35).

Maundy Thursday, also known as Holy Thursday, is a significant day in the Christian year. It commemorates the Last Supper of Jesus Christ with the Twelve Disciples. It is known for a number of distinct practices and traditions; we will observe the following:

Holy Communion: This is a central element of Maundy Thursday services. This is where Jesus shared bread and wine with his disciples, which he identified as his body and blood. We are invited to the same table where Jesus' body is broken, his blood poured out, and his love unyielding.

Stripping of the Church: After communion, the chancel area is stripped of all cloths, candles, and decorations to symbolize the abandonment of Jesus by his disciples and the stripping of Jesus by the soldiers before his crucifixion.

These elements combine to create a service that is reflective, somber, and yet full of deep meaning, as it prepares us for the sorrow of Good Friday and the hope of Easter Sunday.
